Price Cap Program

\$1.989 Per Gallon Leased Tank / \$1.889 Per Gallon Customer Owned Tank

This program lets you cap your fuel price and protects you from price increases through March of 2026.

- Cap your price per gallon through March 31st, 2026, for a one-time \$25.00 enrollment fee.
- This program helps you avoid unexpected price increases during the heating season, giving you peace of mind about your fuel costs.
- To participate in the price cap program, you must have used a minimum of 500 gallons last heating season. If at any time your Tri-Gas Account is 60 days past due, you will lose your price protection without refunds.
- Duration: from time of enrollment through March 31st, 2026.
